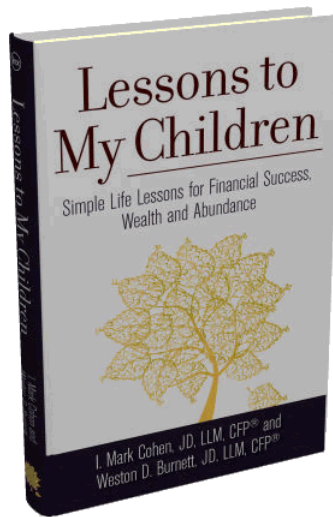

My Thoughts

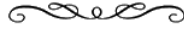
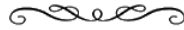
